The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) hereby approves the referenced report. Please delete "draft" from the title page and send one hardcopy and one CD to my attention at the DEC address above. One hardcopy should be placed in the local document repository and the remaining distribution can be made via CD.

The Department now requests that you prepare an interim remedial measure (IRM) work plan to address contaminated soil in the affected area at the site. Pursuant to Section II. B. 1. (b) in the referenced order on consent, please advise the Department in writing within 30 days of this letter as to whether you intend to submit an IRM work plan to address this contamination. Guidance on the preparation of an IRM work plan can be found in Section 1.11 and Chapter 5 of DER-10 Technical Guidance for Site Investigation and Remediation. The IRM work plan should be signed and sealed by a NYS licensed PE. The draft work plan can be submitted electronically for DEC and New York State Department of Health review. Since the IRM is expected to constitute the final remedy for the site, an IRM fact sheet will be disseminated to the public contact list and a 30 day public comment period will be implemented prior to approval of the work plan.
